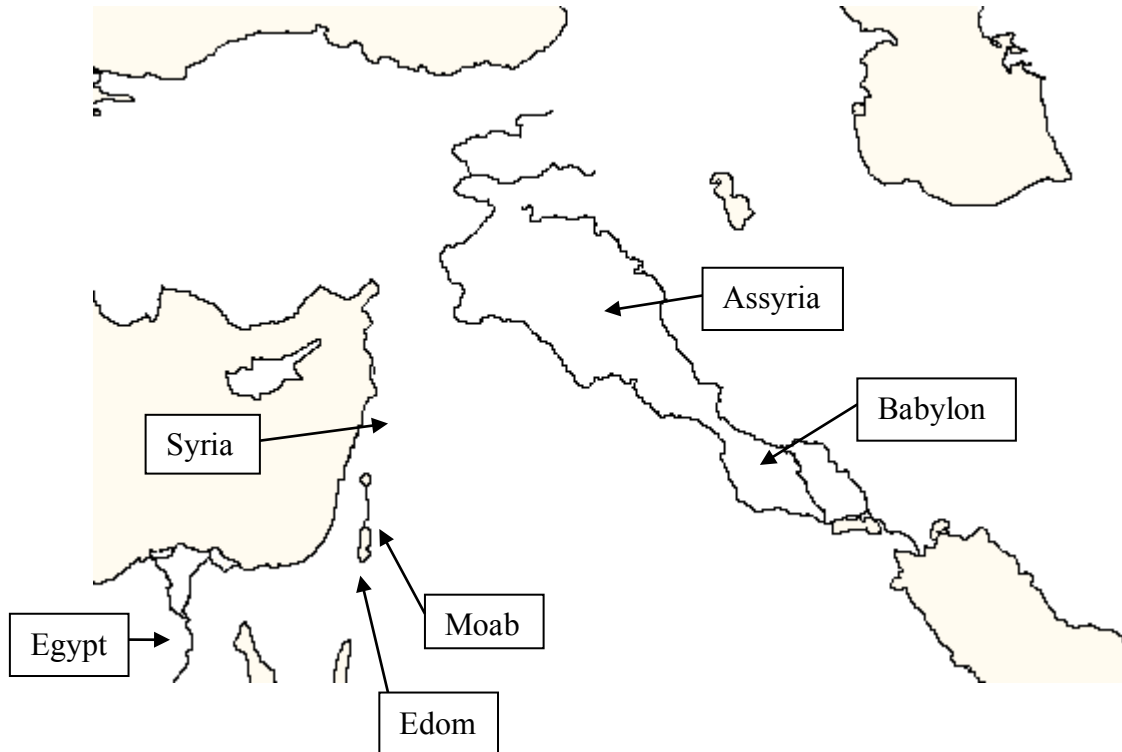


Major Powers Facing Israel & Judah During the Monarchy
